However, I am facing a problem when I am trying to use an environment variable in awk script. `#!/bin/bash export "$1" awk -F, -v var=$1 '{if(match($1, var)) print $0}' test.csv` When I execute this script using the command `bash test.sh mysql`, I get the following error. `awk: cmd. line:5: var=mysql Cannot open var=mysql awk: cmd. line:7: if(match($1, var)) print $0 awk: cmd. line:9: ^ syntax error` If I execute `awk -F, -v var=myenv test.csv` command on the command prompt it works fine. I cannot understand why it is not
